As the holiday season begins, I am reminded of how grateful I am to you for helping us to provide care for individuals, families and the community. After 31 years, we are still here providing care to those in need of healthcare in Will and Grundy Counties.



In case you have not heard, we are expanding our services with a new program that links our clinic and services to other low income healthcare programs in the area. Our collaboration guarantees more of our area's most vulnerable members have a medical home and access to services that meet all their health and wellness needs. We prioritize the health and wellness of our community as a whole. We are already receiving referrals from partner clinics. *John, a referred patient, came into the clinic in October. As reported by Pat one of our volunteer nurses, John was very sick. He had a gastrointestinal bleed, abnormal heart rhythms, high blood pressure, problems with his breath-



ing, and had suffered a stroke. John is uninsured and our partner clinic, who was treating him, could not secure the specialist he needed. By expanding our services and partnering with other clinics in the area, we are opening the door to health and wellness for John and many other patients like him in need of specialist care. The specialist care provided is care that only the

Will-Grundy Medical Clinic can coordinate and secure. Dr. Cerniak, pictured on the left is one of the specialist on John's care team. We are continuing our tradition of providing free care to the uninsured, however, we are now partnering so that more people in the area in need can get healthcare.
